LOCAL LAW NO. 2-1956 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law of the County of Chautauqua for the Year 1956, to Provide for the Establishment of a Commission to Study Methods of Assessment

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

Section I. That there be created in Chautauqua County a Commission composed of five Supervisors and not more than fifteen nor less than five citizens of Chautauqua County, who shall serve without pay.

Section II. That the Commission created by Section I, be, and it hereby is directed to study the methods of assessments of real property in Chautauqua County, that the Commission report its findings and make recommendations for improvements, to the Board of Supervisors within a reasonable time.

Section III. That the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors be authorized to appoint the members of the Commission, a Chairman and a Secretary.

Section IV. That the members of the Commission be paid their necessary expenses and mileage at the usual County rate, as provided by Section 203, Par. 4 of the County Law.

Section V. This Law shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.
