LOCAL LAW NO. 1-1960 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law Authorizing the Clearing and Removal of Ice and Snow from the Runways, Approaches and Roadways at Jamestown Municipal Airport, as a County Purpose

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

LEGISLATIVE DECLARATION

Section 1. A recent survey shows that at lease one-half the persons from the Chautauqua County area who use the Jamestown Airport reside outside the City of Jamestown, and that, therefore, the airport benefits not only the City of Jamestown but also the area of the County outside the City. Chautauqua County hereby recognizes the various benefits which the airport provides to the County as a whole, and in the interest of County-City cooperation for the mutual benefit of the County, the City and the people therein, hereby adopts this local law to provide for the clearing and removal of ice and snow from the runways, approaches, and roadways at the airport by the County Superintendent of Highways with County equipment and personnel and to recognize that this work is a County purpose for which the County may appropriate, raise, and spend County funds.

Section 2. The Board of Supervisors of Chautauqua County is hereby empowered from time to time to authorize and require the County Superintendent of Highways to clear ice and snow from runways, approaches, and other roadways at the Jamestown airport with County equipment and personnel, provided the City of Jamestown adopts a local law authorizing the County, through its Superintendent of Highways, to undertake and perform such work. The Chairman of the Board of Supervisors shall have power, from time to time, to enter into an agreement or agreements with the appropriate official or officials of the City of Jamestown to carry out the purpose of this Local Law.

Section 3. This local law shall take effect immediately.
