

LOCAL LAW NO. 3-1960  
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law Establishing a Department of Planning and Providing for a Planning Director

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby established in and for the County of Chautauqua a Department of Planning.

Section 2. There is hereby created the Office of Planning Director who shall be appointed by the majority vote of all the members of the Board of Supervisors for a term of two years, except that the term of the first appointee to said office shall expire December 31, 1961. The Planning Director shall receive an annual salary to be fixed by the Board of Supervisors. He shall be the head of the Department of Planning and shall be vested with authority, direction and control over said Department, with the power to appoint and remove any officers and employees therein. He shall perform such duties as may be required by law or the Board of Supervisors and shall coordinate his services with the functions performed by the Chautauqua County Planning Board.

Section 3. This Act shall take effect July 1, 1960.
