

LOCAL LAW NO. 4-1960
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law Authorizing Compensation for the Services of Certain Public Officers and
Employees

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 412 of the County Law, or of any other general, special or local law, Charter, ordinance, rule or regulation to the contrary, the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes any County officers or employees who are physicians or undertakers to make claims for and receive fees and compensation in accordance with the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Law or the volunteer Firemen's Benefit Law, and as provided for in Local Law No. 3 year 1956, for compensable professional services rendered by them to or on account of person applying for or receiving benefits from the County of Chautauqua in accordance with and subject to the provisions of such laws; provided however that payment of fees or compensation for such services shall be subject to the limitations set forth in Section 1 of Chapter 809 of the Laws of 1960 of the State of New York.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
