

LOCAL LAW NO. 1-1961  
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law Amending Chapter 780 of the Laws of 1950, as amended, Abolishing the Chautauqua County Navigation Commission and Transferring the Power to Adopt Rules and Regulations Applying to Navigation on and use of the Waters of Chautauqua, Findley and Cassadaga Lakes to the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chautauqua

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

Section 1. The Chautauqua County Navigation Commission is hereby abolished and all of its functions, powers and duties as set forth in The Chautauqua County Navigation Act as amended are hereby terminated.

Section 2. For the purpose of promoting the safety and welfare of persons navigating the waters of Chautauqua, Findley and Cassadaga Lakes and their navigable inlets and outlets and for the preservation of life and property thereon, The Board of Supervisors may make rules and regulations governing the operation of all watercraft on such waters; the construction and placing of docks, wharves, flats, buoys and diving docks on such waters and the use of safety equipment so as to guard against the loss of life by drowning in such waters.

Section 3. All rules and regulations now in effect on such waters which have been heretofore adopted by the Chautauqua County Navigation Commission are continued in effect with the same force and effect as though adopted by the Board of Supervisors, pursuant to Section 2 hereof.

Section 4. All sections or parts thereof of the Chautauqua County Navigation Act which are in conflict with Sections 1 and 2 of this Local Law are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Local Law shall take effect when filed with the Secretary of State.
