## LOCAL LAW NO. 3-61 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law of the County of Chautauqua for the Year 1961, to Provide for the Filing of any Appointive County Office Where a Vacancy Exists

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

Section 1. It shall be lawful for the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chautauqua to appoint any former member of said Board to any appointive County office where a vacancy exists, provided that the former member of the Board to be appointed to such office does not vote on his appointment and resigns from his office of Supervisor prior to such appointment.

Section 2. The Local Law shall take effect immediately.
