LOCAL LAW NO. 1-1968 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

Enabling Act for Resource Conservation and Development Project Plan

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

Section 1. It is the intent of this Local Law to provide measures whereby a Resource conservation and Development Project Plan for Southwestern New York consisting of the Counties of Chautauqua, Cattaraugus, and Allegany can be developed for the purpose of carrying out projects that will benefit the economic prosperity of the area and as authorized by the United States Department of Agriculture, Soil Conservation Service.

Section 2. The Chairman of this Board is hereby authorized to appoint members to a steering committee or any other committee as requested or needed for above stated purposes, which members so appointed may be members of the Board of Supervisors or otherwise. The members of such committee shall be reimbursed far their actual and necessary expenses, including travel expense, incurred in the performance of their duties as provided by the Rules of the Board of Supervisors and which expense shall be a County charge.

Section 3. The County of Chautauqua is hereby authorized to appropriate and expend County funds for the expenses set forth in Section 2 of this Local Law, and to appropriate and expend annually a sum not to exceed the amount of \$250.00 for postage, paper, printing and supplies for committees, to which a member has been appointed as provided in Section 2 of this Local Law, provided however, that the Chautauqua County share of such expenses shall not exceed one-third per centum thereof.

Section 4. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
