LOCAL LAW NO. 1-1969 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law Providing Civil Service Coverage for Employees in Sheriff's Department

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

Section 1. All offices and positions of employment in the Chautauqua County Sheriff's Office and department, except Sheriff, Undersheriff, and Civil Deputies are hereby placed in the classified service of the Civil Service Law of the State of New York.

Section 2. Such offices and positions shall be held and filled according to the provisions of the Civil Service Law and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Civil Service and shall be governed, controlled and subject to such Civil Service Law and such Rules and Regulations.

Section 3. If any section, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgement shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section. Subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase or portion thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgement shall have been rendered.

Section 4. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
