

LOCAL LAW NO. 1-1972  
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law Amending Local Law 3-1960, Section 2 in Relation to the Term of Appointment of  
the Planning Director

BE IT ENACTED, by the Legislature of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

Section 1. Local Law No. 3 of 1960, Section 2 entitled "A Local Law Establishing a Department of Planning and Providing for a Planning Director" is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. There is hereby created the office of Planning Director who shall be appointed by the majority vote of all the members of the County Legislature for a term of one year, except that the term of the appointee to said office shall expires on December 31, 1972 and annually thereafter on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December. The Planning Director shall receive an annual salary to be fixed by the County Legislature. He shall be the head of the Department of Planning and shall be vested with authority, direction and control over said Department, with the power to appoint and remove any officers and employees therein. He shall perform such duties as may be required by law or the County Legislature and shall coordinate his services with the functions performed by the Chautauqua County Planning Board."

Section 2. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
