

LOCAL LAW NO. 2-1973
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law Amending Local Law 3-1960, Section 2 as Amended

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

Resolved, That Local Law 3-1960, Section 2 be amended as follows:

There is hereby created the Office of Planning Director who shall be appointed by the majority vote of all the members of the Board of Legislators for a term of two years, the term of the first appointee to said office shall expire on December 31, 1974. The Planning Director shall receive an annual salary to be fixed by the Board of Legislators. He shall be the head of the Department of Planning and shall be vested with authority, direction and control over said Department, with the power to appoint and remove any officers and employees therein. He shall perform such duties as may be required by law or the Board of Legislators and shall coordinate his services with the functions performed by the Chautauqua County Planning Board.

And further that the original Section 2, as amended, of said Local Law 3-60 be repealed.
