LOCAL LAW NO. 6-1973 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law Amending Local Law No. 1-1971 Increasing Membership of the Industrial Development Commission

BE IT ENACTED, by the Legislature of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

SECTION 1. Local Law No. 1-1971, Section 2 and Section 3 entitled "A Local Law Establishing an Industrial Development Commission" is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The County Legislature hereby establishes a nine member Commission to be known as the Industrial Development Commission.

Section 3. The nine member Commission shall be appointed by the Chairman of the County Legislature with the approval of said Body. The Chairman of said Commission shall be one of its members who shall be so designated by the Chairman of the County Legislature with the approval of said County Legislature, The term of each member of the Commission shall be five years, and the term of two of the members shall expire annually, except each fifth year when the term of one member shall expire provided however, that the first appointments shall be made for the respective terms of five, four, three, two and one years except as hereinafter provided. Of the four new members to be appointed pursuant to this amendment, the first appointments shall be for the respective terms ending December 31, 1973, 1974, 1975, and 1976. The Chairman shall be appointed for a term of one year. Any vacancy occurring in said Commission shall be filled for the unexpired term by appointment in the manner above provided.

SECTION 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
