

LOCAL LAW NO. 1-1974
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law Providing for Salary Adjustments for County Officers

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

SECTION 1. Whereas, all county employees are on the 1974 Salary Schedule but certain county officers are still on the 1971 salary schedule, therefore, this local law is enacted for the purpose of placing all county officers who are on the 1971 graded salary schedule and constitutional officers to more appropriate salary schedules.

SECTION 2. That all county officers on the 1971 graded salary schedule as of the date of enactment of this local law, shall be placed on the 1972 salary schedule as soon as is permissible by law, and on the 1973 salary schedule effective January 1, 1975, provided, however, the total salary and increments, exclusive of longevity, for any county officer presently earning less than \$21,500.00 shall not exceed \$21,500.00.

SECTION 3. That the constitutional officers be placed on the 1973 salary schedule at the beginning of the new term of office.

SECTION 4. That this local law shall not affect any county officer currently earning in excess of \$21,500.00.

SECTION 5. This local law shall become effective 45 days after its adoption.
