LOCAL LAW NO. 1-1975 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law to Enable the County of Chautauqua to Assume the Liability to Save Harmless and Protect the Chautauqua County Clerk and Employees of His Office Pursuant to Section 533 of the County Law of the State of New York

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 533 of the County Law of the State of New York, the County of Chautauqua hereby assumes the liability to save harmless the Chautauqua County Clerk and employees of the County Clerk's Office from financial loss arising out of any claim, demand, suit or judgement by reason of alleged negligence of said County Clerk or employees, provided such act was committed in the discharge of their duties within the scope of their employment.

SECTION 2. The County of Chautauqua may arrange for the purchase and maintain appropriate insurance with any insurance company authorized to do business in the State of New York for coverage against such liability.

SECTION 3. This Local Law shall become effective upon its being filed in the Office of the Secretary of the State of New York following its approval as is provided by the Municipal Home Rule Law.
