## LOCAL LAW NO. 2-1975 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law Authorizing a Petty Cash Fund for Investigative Purposes for the Sheriff's Department

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Local Law is to establish a "Police Investigation Fund" as authorized by the County Law to provide for the payment in advance of audit for expenses necessarily incurred by the Sheriff of Chautauqua in the investigation of criminal activities in the County.

SECTION 2. There is hereby established a fund to be known as the "Police Investigation Fund" for use by the Sheriff. Said fund shall be a revolving cash fund in the amount of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) for the payment in advance of audit of expenditures necessarily incurred in the investigation of criminal activities in the County.

SECTION 3. All expenditures from the Police Investigation Fund shall be subject to audit by the chief fiscal officer of the County, who shall require adequate information concerning the claims and transactions for which expenditures were made. Information designated confidential by the Sheriff, shall be available to the chief fiscal officer but shall not be made public, expect by order of the County Legislature.

SECTION 4. The claimant and the Sheriff shall be jointly and severally liable for any item of expenditure for other than a lawful County purpose disallowed upon final audit.

SECTION 5. This Local Law shall take effect upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.
