

LOCAL LAW NO. 6-1975
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law Amending Section 6 of Local Law No. 4-73

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

SECTION 1. It is the purpose of this Local Law to amend Section 6 of Local Law No. 4-73 – A Local Law Establishing an Office for the Aging in Chautauqua County – to conform to Federal requirements for the selection and qualifications of members of the Advisory Committee for the Aging as established by Local Law No. 4-73.

SECTION 2. Section 6 of Local Law No. 4-73 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 6. Within thirty days from the date of creation of the Office for the Aging, the County Executive with the approval of the County Legislature shall appoint an Advisory Committee for the Aging of not fewer than five (5) members nor more than eleven (11) members, subject to confirmation of the County Legislature, whose function shall be to advise the Director on matters concerning the elderly. The County Executive with the approval of the County Legislature shall appoint one member of the Advisory Committee for the Aging to act as Chairman of said Committee. The Advisory Committee shall consist of representatives of program participants and the general public, including low income and older minority persons at least in proportion to the number of older minority persons in Chautauqua County. The Advisory Committee shall also include at least one (1) representative from the Chautauqua County Nutrition Program for the Elderly Project Council.

SECTION 3. In all other respects Local Law No. 4-73 shall remain unchanged.

SECTION 4. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
