

LOCAL LAW NO. 5-1976
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law Providing Change in Pay Schedule

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

SECTION 1. Whereas, increase in wage rates negotiated with the Civil Service Employees Association, effective July 1, 1976, do not affect the salaries of County Managers not in the bargaining unit and members of the Judiciary, most of whom are not on the 1973 Salary Schedule, therefore, this Local Law is enacted for the purpose of adjusting salaries of the person below listed.

SECTION 2. That upon the effective date of this Local Law, all grades and steps of the appropriate salary schedules and the salaries for non-graded positions for those titles listed below be increased by 3%; that effective January 1, 1977, the then existing appropriate salary schedules be increased by 5%;

Director of Personnel – (At a Minimum of \$23,068.)
County Court Judge
Family Court Judge
Surrogate Court Judge

SECTION 3. This Local Law shall become effective forty-five (45) days after adoption or upon approval of the electors in the event a petition protesting such law shall have been filed in accordance with provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
