LOCAL LAW NO. 5-1979 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law to Amend Article VI, Section 6.04, Subdivision (1) of the Chautauqua Administrative Code in Relation to Purchasing Procedure

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

SECTION I. That Article VI, Section 6.04, Subdivision (1) be, and the same hereby is, amended to read as follows:

Section 6.04 *Purchasing Procedure*

(1) The division of purchasing shall make all purchases of and contracts for supplies, materials, equipment and services for the County, the Legislature or any administrative unit for which the County shall be liable for payment (the payment of which the County shall be liable). The division of purchasing shall make all such purchases or contracts of purchase in accordance with the competitive bidding requirements and limits set forth in Article 5-A of the General Municipal Law (The Legislature shall fix a sum not to exceed one thousand, five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) as the limit above which any such purchase or contract of purchase shall not be made without) by publishing an advertisement, when required by the General Municipal Law, in the County's official newspaper (printed in the English language and published in the County of Chautauqua), which advertisement shall invite sealed bids for the same, provided that the purchase of perishable food stuffs, drug, and medical supplies may be made without public advertisement when expressly permitted by written order of the County Executive.

SECTION II. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
