

LOCAL LAW NO. 6-1979
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law to Amend Article XV, Section 15.01 of the Chautauqua Administrative Code in
Relation to the Attendance of Advisory Board Members at the Meetings of Their Respective
Boards

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

SECTION 1. That Article XV, Section 15.01 of the Chautauqua Administrative Code be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Except as otherwise provided in the Charter or Code, every other board, the members of which are appointed, shall be an advisory board. The members thereof shall be appointed for such terms as are or may be provided in the Charter and Code.

Wherever provision is made in the Charter or Code for the appointment of an advisory board, the members so appointed, unless otherwise provided, shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing authority.

"All members of such advisory boards, however appointed, shall be deemed to have resigned their membership on any advisory board when such member shall fail to attend three (3) consecutive meetings of the advisory board without being excused by the Chairman."

SECTION 2. This Local Law is subject to a permissive referendum shall take effect forty-five (45) days after adoption.
