LOCAL LAW NO. 8-1979 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law Amending Article III, Section 3.03 of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code in Relation to Executive Approval of Local Enactments

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

Section 1. The Chautauqua County Code, Article III, Section 3.03 be, and the same hereby is amended as follows:

Section 3.03 Executive Approval

Within ten (10) days after receipt of a (local law or) legislative resolution as passed by the County Legislature, the County Executive shall approve or veto the same. A local law as passed by the County Legislature shall be submitted to the County Executive for action in accordance with Sections 20 and 21 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

- (a) Approval. If the (local law or) legislative resolution is approved by the County Executive, he shall endorse the original document and return it to the Clerk of the County Legislature within (such) ten (10) days *from the date of which the County Executive received the resolution*.
- (b) Veto. If the (local law or) legislative resolution is vetoed by the County Executive, he shall so indicate in writing setting forth his objections thereto and within ten (10) days after receipt *of such resolution* (thereof) return the original document to the Clerk of the County Legislature with his veto message attached. In the case of adoption of the annual budget, the *County* (Chief) Executive shall have the power to veto specific items, which the County Legislature may have changed from the original budget proposal submitted by the County Executive, without vetoing the entire budget.
- (c) Failure to Act. In the event that the County Executive fails to approve or veto a legislative resolution within (10) days following the date of its receipt from the Clerk of the County Legislature, such resolution shall be deemed enacted.

Section 2. This Local Law shall take effect as of the date of its filing in the Office of Secretary of State.
