## LOCAL LAW NO. 2-1980 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

(A Local Law Increasing the Membership of the Chautauqua County Emergency Medical Services Council)

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

**SECTION 1. INTENT** 

The Chautauqua County Legislature hereby finds that with the increasing need for emergency medical services and the efficient planning, promotion, coordination and delivery of same to the residents of Chautauqua County, the number of members of the Chautauqua County Emergency Services Council should be increased.

SECTION II. AMENDMENT OF LOCAL LAW NO. 9-1975

The first sentence of Section 4 of Local Law No. 9-1975 is hereby amended as follows:

The Chautauqua County Emergency Medical Services *Council* shall consist of *not more than 35, not less than* 20 (23) members appointed by the County Executive, subject to confirmation by the County Legislature.

SECTION III. CONTINUATION OF LOCAL LAW NO. 9-1975, AS AMENDED

In all other aspects, Local Law No. 9-1975 shall remain unchanged.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect as of the date of its filing in the office of the Secretary of State.
