

LOCAL LAW NO. 4-1982
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

AMENDING ARTICLE 1 OF THE CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY CHARTER IN RELATION
TO THE CONTINUANCE OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AGENCIES, COMMITTEES
AND BOARDS

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

SECTION 1. The Chautauqua County Charter, Article 1, Section 1.04 be and the same hereby is amended as follows:

Section 1.04 Existing Legislation Continued

Except to the extent to which they may be inconsistent with the provision of the Charter, all existing laws, resolutions, rules and regulations heretofore adopted, shall continue in force and effect until amended, superseded or repealed. All commissions, agencies, committees and boards of the County of Chautauqua shall cease three years from this law's filing in the Office of the Secretary of State, and every three years thereafter, unless the County Legislature, and County Executive, by affirmative action, extend and continue said commissioners, agencies, committees and boards.

SECTION 2. This Local Law shall, subject to a referendum on petition, take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State, with the first usage of this provision to become effective three years from the date of final adoption of this law.
