CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

AMENDING ARTICLE 13 OF THE CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY CHARTER TO PROHIBIT
SALARY CHANGES FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS FOR THE TERM FOR WHICH THEY
WERE ELECTED

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

Section 1. Article 13 of the Chautauqua County Charter is hereby amended by adding a new Section 13.04 as follows:

Section 13.04 Salary Increases. The salary of any officer elected for a fixed term shall not be increased or diminished between the date of such election and the expiration of such term except (1) in accordance with a schedule adopted prior to the time such officers was elected to office which provides higher or lower rates of compensation during said term, or (2) as otherwise mandated by State or Federal laws, rules or regulations.

Section 2. This Local Law, subject to a permissive referendum in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law, shall take effect forty-five (45) days after adoption unless a referendum is required, in which case it shall take effect upon approval or the affirmative vote of the majority of the qualified electors voting on the proposition.
