## LOCAL LAW NO. 3-1987 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

## A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND SECTION 3.02 (i) OF ARTICLE 3 OF THE CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY CHARTER TO CHANGE THE NAME OF OFFICE OF CIVIL DEFENSE

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

Section I. <u>Intent.</u> It is the intent of this Local Law to change the title of the Civil Defense Director.

Section II. That the Chautauqua County Charter, Article III, Section 2.02 (i) be and the same hereby is amended as follows:

(i) Appoint, subject to confirmation by the County Legislature, the County Historian, (Civil Defense Director) <u>Director of Emergency Management and Civil Defense</u>, Fire Coordinator, and all other County officers, except as provided in this Charter.

Section III. <u>Effective Date.</u> This Local Law shall take effect forty-five (45) days after adoption or upon approval o the electors in the event a petition requesting a referendum is filed pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Law.
