LOCAL LAW NO. 8-1988 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR A MANAGEMENT SALARY PLAN FOR COUNTY OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES FOR 1987-1989

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

Section 1. General. This Local Law authorizes the payment of compensation needed to recruit and retain qualified offices and employees for the County of Chautauqua, and supersedes Local Law 7-1984 relating to the Management Salary Plan for certain County officers and employees. Appointing authorities retain the discretion to set salaries within specific ranges established hereunder, based on actual performance and not on the length of employment.

Section 2. <u>Salary Levels.</u> The annual salary level for County officers and employees within the titles specified below shall be in accordance with the following management salary schedule. In the event that this Local Law becomes effective after January 1, 1988, the remaining 1988 salary payments for such officers and employees shall be adjusted appropriately so that they receive the full amount of the 198 salary increase.

Section 3. <u>Annual Review.</u> No later than June of each year, the County Executive shall review the Management Salary Plan and make recommendations to the County Legislature concerning adjustments and amendments to the Plan.

Section 4. <u>Severability.</u> In the event any provisions or part of this Local Law shall for any reason be adjudged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of the Local Law.

Section 5. <u>Effectiveness.</u> This Local Law shall become effective forty-five (45) days after adoption, or upon approval by a majority of the qualified electors in the event a permissive referendum is held in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law.
