

LOCAL LAW NO. 21-90
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

AMENDING THE CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE (Re: Insurance
Services)

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York
as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby enacted a new Section 9.04 of Article 9 Department of
Finance of the Chautauqua County Code to read as follows:

Section 9.04 Division of Insurance Services

The Division of Insurance shall be headed by a Deputy Director who shall be known as
the Director of the Division of Insurance. His duties shall include administration of the
Liability and Casualty Reserve Fund; all of the County's self-insured health plans, the County
Self-Insured Worker's Compensation Insurance Plan; the Municipal Self-Insured Health
Insurance Plan; the County Self-Insured Unemployment Insurance Plan, and the responsibility
for obtaining such additional insurance policies for property, liability, health, automobile and
others as necessary. He shall also be responsible for the development and administration of a
risk management program and perform such other and related duties as may be prescribed by
the Director of Finance.

SECTION 2. All other provisions of the Chautauqua County Code, Local Law 3-74, as
previously amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This Local Law, subject to a mandatory referendum in accordance with
the Municipal Home Rule Law, shall become effective upon approval of the affirmative vote of
a majority of the qualified electors of County government voting upon the proposition at the
next general election held not less than sixty (60) days after the adoption hereof or at a special
election held not less than sixty (60) days after adoption, the date for which to be set by
resolution of the Legislature.
