LOCAL LAW NO. 22-90 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

AMENDING THE CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY CHARTER (Re: Insurance Services)

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

- <u>SECTION 1.</u> There is hereby added a new Section 9.01 (k) of Article 9, Department of Finance of the Chautauqua County Charter to read as follows:
- (k) The Director shall be responsible for liability, property health, <u>unemployment</u>, <u>worker's compensation</u> and all other insurance functions. [, except unemployment and worker's compensation].
- <u>SECTION 2.</u> All other provisions of the Chautauqua County Charter, Local Law 13-73, as previously amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This Local Law, subject to a mandatory referendum in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law, shall become effective upon approval by the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of County government voting upon the proposition at the next general election held not less than sixty (60) days after the adoption hereof or at a special election held not less than sixty (60) days after adoption, the date for which to be set by resolution of the Legislature.
