

LOCAL LAW NO. 12-91
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE- RE:
COUNTY BUDGET

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

SECTION 1. The last sentence of Subsection b of Section 15.03 of Article 15 of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code is hereby amended as follows:

In the event of the failure of the head of any administrative unit or authorized Agency to submit and file such estimate and request on or before August [1] 15, the Budget Director shall forthwith prepare and file same accordingly.

SECTION 2. Subsection b of Section 15.05 of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code is hereby amended in each sentence where it refers to the first Wednesday of or in October to read the third Wednesday of or in October.

SECTION 3. Section 15.05 (b) and 15.06 of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code is hereby amended as follows:

15.05 (b): Said report shall immediately be [mailed] delivered to all County Legislators, County Executive and all department heads and agencies involved.

15.06: The date and time of the public hearing on the tentative budget shall be [2:00] 7:30 p.m. [o'clock in the afternoon] on the third Wednesday of October and shall be continued at [7:30 o'clock}] 2:00 p.m. the same evening on the fourth [second] Wednesday in October, at which time any person may be heard for or against recommendations made by the County Executive or any other comments relevant to the operating and capital budget.

SECTION 4. The first sentence of the eighth paragraph of Section 15.07 of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code is hereby amended as follows:

Six (6) copies of the budget, as adopted, shall be certified by the County Executive and by the Clerk of the Legislature and (1) each of such copies shall be filed in the office of the County Executive, the offices of the Comptroller, the Director of Finance and the Clerk of the Legislature and two (2) of such copies shall be filed in the office of the Budget Director.

SECTION 5. All other provisions of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code as previously amended shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. This Local Law shall become effective forty-five (45) days after adoption, or upon approval by a majority of the qualified electors in the event a permissive referendum is held in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law.
