## LOCAL LAW NO. 6-91 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

## A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY CODE RE: TERM OF OFFICE FOR IDA BOARD MEMBERS

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> Section 11.06 of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Industrial Development Agency. It shall function as prescribed by this law and Section 856 of the New York State Industrial Development Agency Act with the exception that the County Executive shall appoint its members and designate the Chairman, with the approval of the Legislature. Beginning January 1, 1992, three (3) members shall be appointed to an initial two (2) year term, and four (4) members to an initial four (4) year term and thereafter all terms shall be four (4) years. In addition to the powers defined in the New York State Act, its principal purpose shall be to borrow money and issue bonds to underwrite undertakings fostered by the Industrial and Economic Development Commission and/or the Division of Development. It shall have all the powers and duties of a County Industrial Development Agency, heretofore or hereafter lawfully granted or imposed by the County Charter, this Code, local law, ordinance or resolution of the Legislature, order or direction of the County Executive, or by any applicable provisions of any act of the State Legislature not inconsistent with the County Charter or this Code.

Section 2. This Local Law shall become effective forty-five (45) days after adoption, or upon approval by a majority of the qualified electors in the event a permissive referendum is held in accordance with Municipal Home Rule Law.
