

LOCAL LAW NO. 7-91
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

AMENDING CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY CHARTER RE: ADOPTION OF BUDGET

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

Section 1. Section 2.05 (b) of Article 2 of the Chautauqua County Charter is hereby amended to read as follows:

(b) To make appropriations, incur indebtedness, adopt the budget, and levy taxes. In the event the Legislature fails to finally adopt a budget for any insuring fiscal year on or before December 1, the tentative budget shall constitute the budget for such ensuing fiscal year. The appropriation resolution and the resolution authorizing the levy of taxes shall be deemed to have been passed by the Legislature as of such date.

Section 2. This Local law shall become effective forty-five (45) days after adoption, or upon approval by a majority of the qualified electors in the event a permissive referendum is held in accordance with Municipal Home Rule Law.
