LOCAL LAW NO. 15-92 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW 7-90 PROVIDING FOR A MANAGEMENT SALARY PLAN FOR COUNTY OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES (1992 Salary Increase)

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Purpose.</u> The purpose of this Local Law is to amend Local Law 7-90 to provide County mangers a 3% salary increase in 1992.

Section 2. 1992 Manager Salary Increases. The salaries for County Officers and employees covered by the Management Salary Plan contained in Local Law 7-90, as amended, except those officers and employees with designated flat salaries, shall be increased 3% in accordance with the formula below:

Current salary x .0300
Number of pay periods
Remaining following
Effective date of this local law

<u>Section 3.</u> Other Officers and Employees. Officers and employees with designated flat salaries shall be paid the salary that is set pursuant to a duly adopted resolution or local law.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Severability.</u> In the event any provisions of part of this Local Law shall for any reason be adjudged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of the Local Law.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effectiveness.</u> This Local Law shall become effective forty-five (45) days after adoption, or upon approval by a majority of the qualified electors in the event a permissive referendum is held in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law.
