

LOCAL LAW NO. 16-92
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATIONS TO COUNTY MUNICIPALITIES
AND FIRE DISTRICTS FOR FIRE PROTECTION AND MUTUAL AID PROGRAM

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York
as follows:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Local Law is to authorize the County of Chautauqua to appropriate funds to assist municipalities and fire districts in furnishing fire fighting and/or emergency rescue services to County residents. It is the intent of this Local Law to enhance to the County's fire protection and mutual aid programs for the benefits of the safety, health and welfare of County residents.

Section 2. Authorization. The County of Chautauqua is hereby authorized pursuant to a duly adopted resolution to appropriate funds to assist municipalities and fire districts in furnishing fire fighting and/or emergency rescue services to County residents for the purpose of improving fire protection, mutual aid, emergency rescue or other related services for County residents.

Section 3. Severability. In the event any provisions or part of this Local Law shall for any reason be adjudged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of the Local Law.

Section 4. Effectiveness. This Local Law shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.
