

LOCAL LAW NO. 5-92
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE
RE: TELECOMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

Section 1. Article VI, Section 6.04 of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding a new subsection 7 to read as follows:

6.04 (7) Be responsible for the operation and maintenance of all County government telecommunication resources including, but not limited to, telephone and fax services.

Section 2. The fourth Division set forth in the first paragraph of Section 9.00 of Article IX of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code is retitled as Division of Data Processing and Section 9.00 (d) is hereby amended to read as follows:

(d) The Division of [Information Services] Data Processing shall be headed by a Deputy Director appointed by the Director of Finance.

Section 3. Article IX, Section 9.05 of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code is retitled as Division of Data Processing and Section 9.05 (d) is hereby deleted in its entirety.

Section 4. This Local Law shall become effective forty-five (45) days after adoption, or upon approval by a majority of the qualified electors in the event a permissive referendum is held in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law.
