LOCAL LAW NO. 5-92 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY ADMINISTRAIVE CODE RE: TELECOMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> Article VI, Section 6.04 of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding a new subsection 7 to read as follows:

- <u>6.04 (7) Be responsible for the operation and maintenance of all County government telecommunication resources including, but not limited to, telephone and fax services.</u>
- Section 2. The fourth Division set forth in the first paragraph of Section 9.00 of Article IX of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code is retitled as <u>Division of Data Processing</u> and Section 9.00 (d) is hereby amended to read as follows:
- (d) The Division of [Information Services] <u>Data Processing</u> shall be headed by a Deputy Director appointed by the Director of Finance.
- <u>Section 3.</u> Article IX, Section 9.05 of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code is retitled as <u>Division of Data Processing</u> and Section 9.05 (d) is hereby deleted in its entirety.
- <u>Section 4.</u> This Local Law shall become effective forty-five (45) days after adoption, or upon approval by a majority of the qualified electors in the event a permissive referendum is held in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law.
