LOCAL LAW NO. 7-92 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

AMENDING LOCAL LAW 1-90 REGULATING SPEED ON LAKES IN CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

Section 1. Section 3, paragraph 2 of Local Law 1-90 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2. No vessel shall be operated on <u>Chautauqua Lake</u> within two hundred, <u>(200)</u> feet or <u>on Findley Lake within one hundred (100) feet</u> of the shore, a dock, pier, raft, float or an anchored or moored vessel at a speed exceeding five <u>(5)</u> miles per hour, unless such vessel is being operated near such shore, dock, float, pier, raft, or anchored vessel for the purpose of enabling a person engaged in water skiing to take off or land.

Section 2. All other provisions of Local Law 1-90 shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Local Law shall become effective upon fling with the Secretary of State, after being approved in writing by the New York State Commissioner of Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation.
