

LOCAL LAW NO. 3-93
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY CODE OF ETHICS

BE IT ENACTED, by the Chautauqua County Legislature as follows:

SECTUIN 1, The Chautauqua County Code of Ethics, as enacted by Local Law 3-90, as amended by Local Law 5-91 and Local Law 18-91, is hereby further amended.

SECTION 2. Section 4. Conflicts of Interest of County Officers and Employees of the Code of Ethics is amended by adding a new subparagraph 5 as follows:

Nothing in this Local Law shall be construed to prohibit an unpaid member of a County agency from acting or appearing for a third party regarding a matter unrelated to the business of heir County agency, nor prohibit a County officer or employee who is an elected public official or another government entity from acting or appearing in their official capacity on behalf of such other governmental entity.

SECTION 3. Chautauqua County Soil and Water Conservation District members are hereby added to the list of public officials subject to financial disclosure as set forth in Section 8, Subsection 1 of Local Law 3-90, as amended by Local Law 5-91 and Local Law 16-91.

SECTION 4. This Local Law shall be effective immediately upon filing with the New York Secretary of State.
