LOCAL LAW NO. 4-94 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

AMENDING THE CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE REGARDING RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR BOARDS, COUNCILS, AND COMMISSIONS

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

Section 1. Section 13.13 of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 13.13 All County Boards

All County boards, <u>councils</u>, and commissions required by State Law shall be continued. Other boards, <u>councils</u>, and commissions may be continues and/or created as deemed necessary by the County Legislature. <u>Throughout their term of office</u>, the members of any such boards, councils, or commissions shall either be a resident of the County, own real property in the County, or be employed in the County.

Section 2. This Local Law shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.
