

LOCAL LAW NO. 5-94
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW 7-90 PROVIDING FOR A MANAGEMENT
SALARY PLAN FOR COUNTY OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Local Law is to enable management salary levels to be adjusted in a manner consistent with the adopted 1994 County budget.

Section 2. Adjustment of Salary Ranges. The maximum level of current management salary ranges established by the County Legislature pursuant to Local Law 7-90, as amended, shall be increased by 2.5% except for positions with designated flat salaries. The minimum level of the management salary ranges shall remain unchanged. The maximum level of the salary range shall be a cap on the amount which may be paid for a full year of service.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Local Law shall become effective forty-five (45) days after adoption or upon approval by a majority of the qualified electors in the event a permissive referendum is held in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law.
