

LOCAL LAW NO. 22-95
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW REPEALING LOCAL LAW 2-66 OF THE COUNTY OF
CHAUTAUQUA

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

1. Purpose. The purposed of this Local Law is to repeal in its entirety Local Law 2-66 of the County of Chautauqua. Local Law 2-66 established the Office of the Public Defender, and required that the term of office of the Public Defender be the same as the term of office of the legislative body. The Chautauqua County Charter has reconfirmed the establishment of the Office of Public Defender, and it is desired that the term of office of the Public Defender be fixed in the manner otherwise provided by law. The provisions of Local Law 2-66 are therefore no longer necessary.

2. Repeal. Local Law 2-66 of the County of Chautauqua, enacted March 11, 1966 and filed in the office of the Secretary of State on March 18, 1966, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

3. Effective Date. This Local Law shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.
