

LOCAL LAW NO. 7-95
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW AUTHORIZING ACQUISITION OF FIRE PROTECTION EQUIPMENT
AND CONTRACTS FOR USE AND SALE OF SUCH EQUIPMENT

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature as follows:

Section 1. Purpose. It is the intent of this Local Law to enhance the County's fire protection and mutual aid programs for the benefit of the safety, health and welfare of County residents by authorizing the County of Chautauqua to acquire fire protection equipment and contract for its use and sale with fire departments in the County.

Section 2. Authorization. Upon the recommendation of the County Fire Advisory Board and the County Fire Coordinator, the County Executive is authorized to acquire fire protection equipment and contract with municipalities, fire districts, and incorporated and unincorporated fire companies for the lease, purchase, sale, installment sale, operation, maintenance, and repair of such equipment and for the furnishing of fire protection to County residents. Notwithstanding any law, rule, or regulations to the contrary, a sale of fire protection equipment pursuant to this local law may be made at private sale without public advertisement or bid.

Section 3. Effective Date. This local law shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.
