

LOCAL LAW NO. 12-96
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

AMENDING LOCAL LAW INTRO. NO. 14-96 REGARDING ASSISTANCE TO
MUNICIPALITIES WITH ENFORCEMENT OF LAND USE LAWS AND REGULATIONS

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York
as follows:

1. Section 1 of Local Law Intro. 14-96 of the County of Chautauqua is hereby amended
as follows:

1. Purpose. Purpose of this Local Law is to authorize the County of Chautauqua to
assist other county municipalities with the enforcement of land use laws and regulations,
including zoning and building codes. It is the intent of this Local Law to protect and enhance
the safety, health, and welfare of County residents and property. It is contemplated that County
assistance will be rendered only in the case of extraordinary enforcement actions involving
substantial costs.

2. This Local Law shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.
