LOCAL LAW NO. 8-96 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW AUTHORIZING ASSISTANCE TO MUNICIPALITIES WITH ENFORCEMENT OF LAND USE LAWS AND REGULATIONS

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

- 1. **Purpose.** The purpose of this local law is to authorize the County of Chautauqua assist other County municipalities with the enforcement of land use laws and regulations, including zoning and building codes. It is the intent of this local law to protect and enhance the safety, health, and welfare of County residents and property.
- 2. **Authorization.** The County of Chautauqua is hereby authorized to assist other County municipalities with the enforcement of land use laws and regulations. Such assistance may be in the form of grants, loans, or in-kind services.
- 3. **Severability.** In the event any provisions or part of this local law shall for any reason be adjudged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of the local law.
- 4. **Effective Date.** This local law shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.
