WHEREAS, the Mental Hygiene Law department expenses have exceeded initial budgetary estimates and it is mandated this department's expenses be funded by local share; and

WHEREAS, some Mental Hygiene departmental appropriations have a surplus; and

WHEREAS, a purchase order for grant-funded equipment was prepared in 2020 for the Department of Mental Hygiene, but the purchase was not completed in 2020; and

WHEREAS, 2020 revenue for the Department of Mental Hygiene is short of budget partially because grant revenue could not be earned since corresponding equipment was not purchased; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 expenditure budget for the equipment was encumbered so it automatically rolled forward into the 2021 budget, but the corresponding revenue budget for the equipment did not automatically roll forward into the 2021 budget; now therefore be it

WHEREAS, the Office of Community Renewal awarded Chautauqua County \$204,500 under the 2019 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program CDBG# 222WS320-19, a federally funded program authorized by Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, for the Chautauqua Septics and Wells Program, which assists low/ moderate income homeowners with necessary repairs to existing household water and wastewater systems, including lateral connections to municipal systems; and

WHEREAS, the CDBG program is administered by the New York State Office of Community Renewal (OCR) and provides resources to eligible local governments for housing, economic development, public facilities, public infrastructure, and planning activities, with the principal purpose of benefitting low/moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing is required pursuant to 24 CFR §§570.431 and 570.486, and in compliance with the requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, to provide further information to the public about the progress of the ongoing CDBG project and to accept public comments related to the effectiveness of the administration of the CDBG project; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Chautauqua County Legislature hold a public hearing for the aforementioned purposes during the regular meeting of the County Legislature on March 24, 2021, at 6:35 p.m., in a manner consistent with CDBG program requirements; and be it further;

AT THE REQUEST OF: County Executive Paul M. Wendel, Jr.:

WHEREAS, the Office of Community Renewal is expected to release a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for the 2021 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, a federally funded program authorized by Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, under its Housing Resources NOFA, during spring 2021; and

WHEREAS, the CDBG Program Housing Resources program provides funding to eligible communities for housing activities including housing rehabilitation, homeownership, manufactured housing rehabilitation or replacement, well and septic replacement, and lateral connection assistance that primarily benefits low- and moderate-income persons; and

WHEREAS, the County is considering applying for funding for the Chautauqua Septics and Wells Program, under this NOFA, for those residing in eligible, non-entitlement communities within Chautauqua County; and

WHEREAS, the County seeks public input on community development, housing needs, and proposed activities under the CDBG program, especially input from low- and moderate-income residents; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Chautauqua County Legislature hold a public hearing for the aforementioned purposes during the regular meeting of the County Legislature on March 24, 2021, at 6:40 p.m., in a manner consistent with CDBG program requirements; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Legislature is authorized and directed to post notice of the public hearing in the Gerace Office Building and to publish notice of the hearing at least seven (7) days prior thereto in the official newspapers of the County of Chautauqua in such form as is approved by the Chautauqua County Law Department.
