



COVID-19 Statistics for February 13-February 19, 2022

(updated at 12:00 on 2/23/22)

Changes to data reporting (beginning week ending 2/12/22):

- -Total number of patients in local hospitals with COVID-19, and percent fully vaccinated in hospitals have been removed from the dashboard. Percent fully vaccinated in hospital pie chart has been removed.
 - -Reason for change: HERDS survey now includes the number of people admitted to the hospital due to COVID or COVID complications. This figure more accurately represents the burden placed on hospitals because of COVID-19. Vaccination status is not available for this metric. Additionally, vaccination statuses reported on the past did not include information specifically about boosters, which have proven to be very important for elderly and those with underlying conditions.
- COVID-19 Cases Reported Since August 1, 2021 by Known Vaccination Status has been removed.
 - -Reason for change: With very few case investigations occurring due to changes in COVID-19 protocols, vaccination status is unknown for the majority of cases. This figure is no longer accurate or helpful.
- Please also note that cases and deaths reported here reflect a MINIMUM number of cases in the community during the reporting timeframe. With over-the-county rapid tests widely available, many cases in the community remain unreported. We are not always made aware of COVID-19 deaths, and sometimes these are reported to us up to several weeks after the death occurred. Data reported here are preliminary, and are subject to change.






