



COVID-19 Statistics for February 20-February 26, 2022

(updated at 4:15 p.m. on 3/1/22)

Beginning next week, the Chautauqua County Health Department will no longer report weekly COVID-19 case numbers. Due to a community shift to rapid testing resources, we are only aware of a fraction of cases occurring in the community. Our department will be compiling a list of data resources for individuals interested in monitoring the progress of the pandemic, and will continue to report of some of the measures included here. Check back next week for the updated reporting format.

Please note that the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has updated its methodology for reporting community COVID-19 levels. These levels are determined by hospital beds being used, hospital admissions, and the total number of new COVID-19 cases in a county. Levels are listed as low, medium, or high. 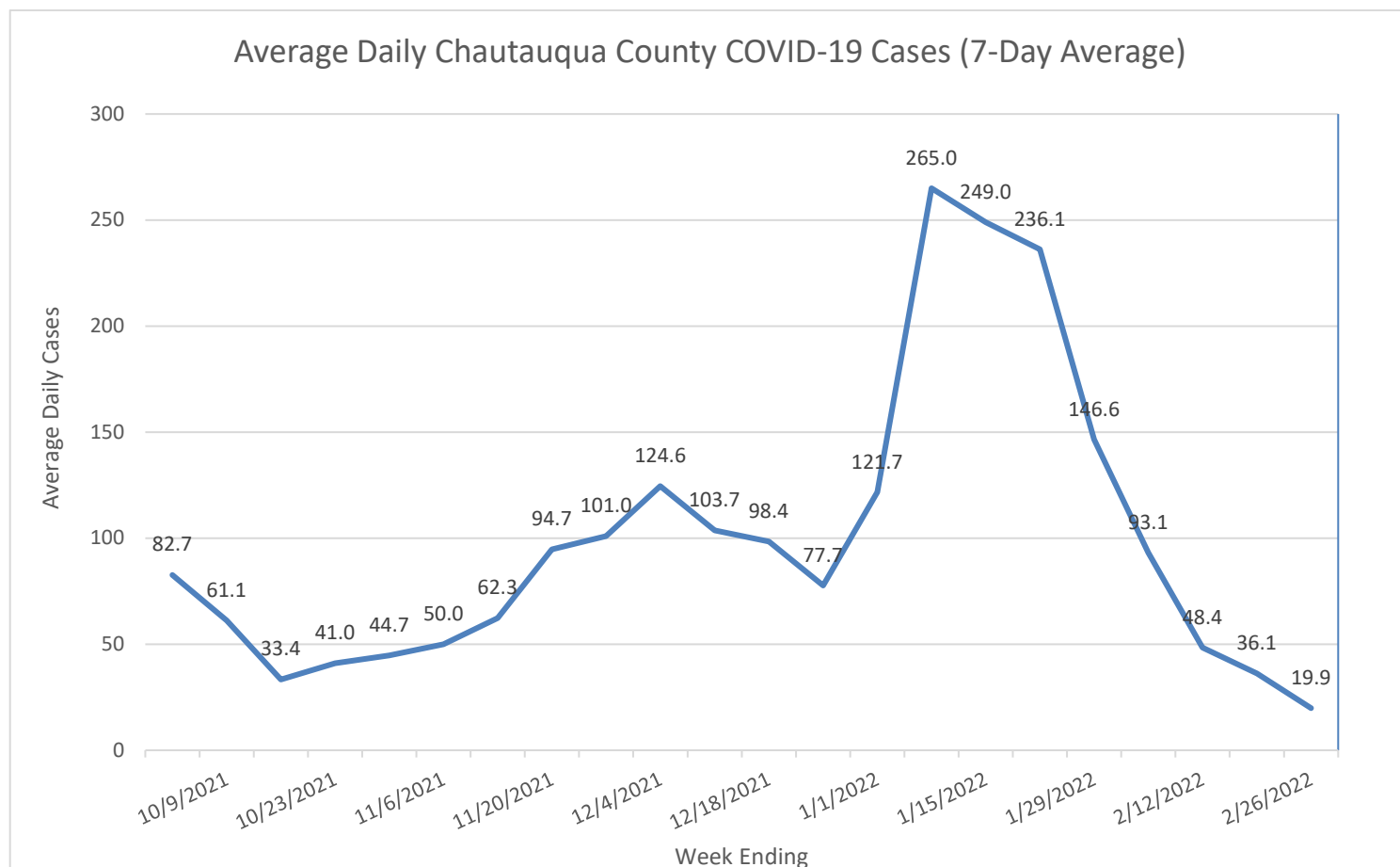

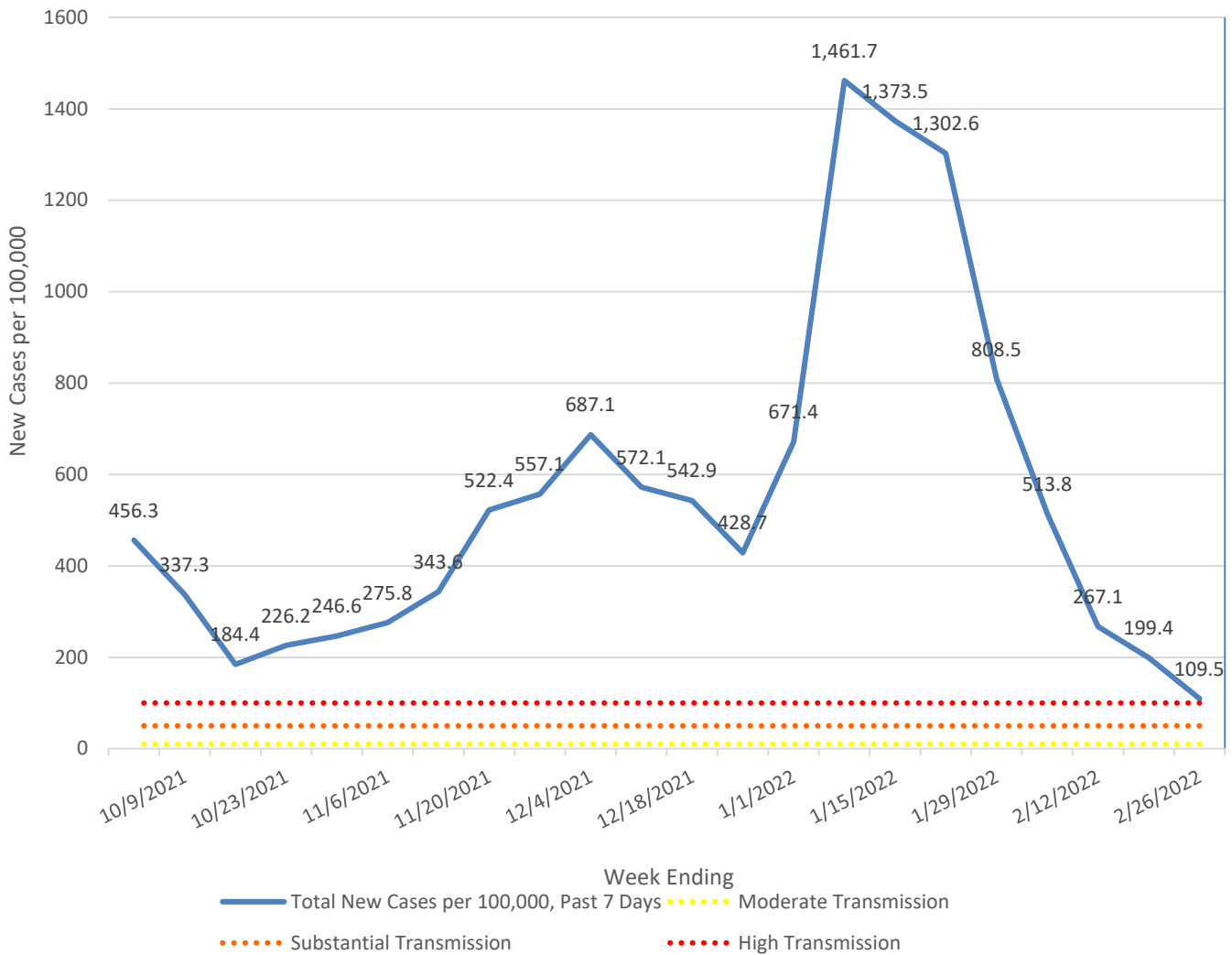

Total New Cases per 100,000 Persons in the Past 7 Days, Chautauqua County



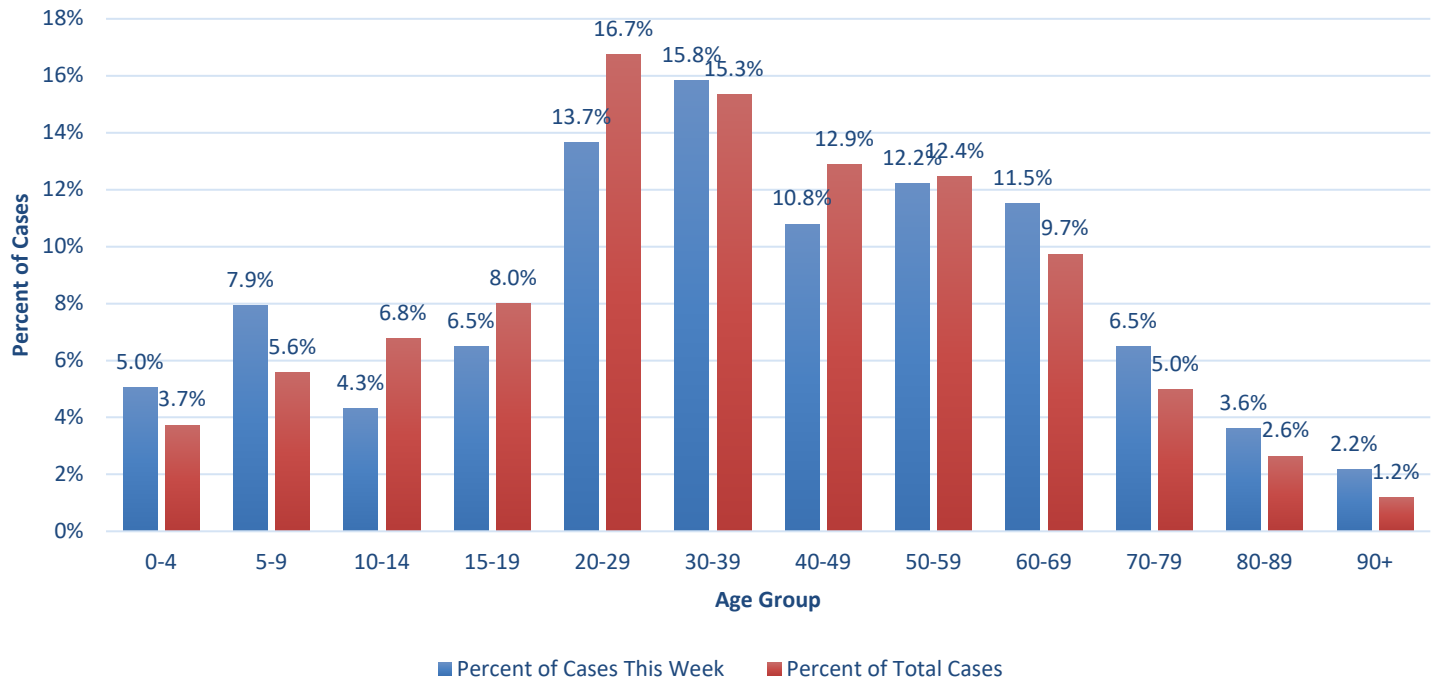
