

Fredonia Newspaper Items

There have been a good number of newspapers published in Fredonia, although not all of them survived for very long. From the earliest, the *Chautauque Gazette*, through *The Fredonia Censor*, *The Frontier Express* and *The Fredonia Express* to the *Fredonia Advertiser*, all carried notices of Marriages and Deaths. The monumental work by Lois Barris has made available that information derived from the *Censor* and other papers. It still remains to search other sources to gather as complete a record as possible of these early events so important to genealogists and historians alike.

I have already written about what is available in the *Fredonia Advertiser* in the CCGS Newsletter (Vol.22,p.61). What follows is an account of those entries in two other papers, not found in the printed indexes to 19th-Century Deaths and Marriages, or those entries that differ in some way from the printed versions.

The Barker Historical Museum has copies of *The Frontier Express* from 1847 and 1848, and microfilm copies of *The Fredonia Express* for 30 May 1848 and for most of 1849 (13 February through 25 December). Although there are some duplications between the newspapers' listings of marriages and deaths and those indexed for the Chautauqua County Genealogical Society, there are a good number of entries that are not duplicates.

The entries that are not in the printed indexes, or that differ in some way from those entries, are given here in their original chronological order. The Marriages are given first, then the Deaths. Each entry is preceded by a sequential number.

There is one Family Name Index giving the last name and the assigned number. The names of the participating clergy are not included in this index.

Because the copies of *The Fredonia Express* are in microform only, it will be necessary for a searcher to use the microfilm reader at the Barker Historical Museum to verify the accuracy of any entry in this printed version.

By the above sudden, mysterious and afflictive dispensation of Divine Providence we have been deprived of a brother-in-law, who stood high in the estimation of all who knew him for his probity and worth. Struck down almost in his full strength, while on a visit, designed to be the occasion of but a few days absence from his family, we are forcibly taught the lesson that even "in the midst of life we are in death." Though he died away from his home, away from the wife of his youth, and the known and loved of many of his children, his friends and neighbors, yet the consolation remains that he still "died among his kindred."

1 August 1848

11) At Mayville, on the 26th July, Johnathan Brigham, a soldier and Patriot of the Revolution. He was among the earliest settlers of the country, and universally esteemed and beloved for his virtues and worth. So pass away the Father of the Republic. But let not the bright examples of their Lives be lost upon their sons. Let the rich inheritance of Liberty, be transmitted unimpaired, until an emancipated world *can rejoice* in the blessing of Freedom.

12) In Pomfret, July 22d, Mr.Reuben Munger aged 79 years.

Some years since this highly respectable citizen emigrated to this County to spend the remainder of his days with his amiable companion, with their children, who principally reside in Stockton. He numbered his days in peace, and went down to the grave honored and respected; and by a life of virtue and integrity, he reared in the hearts of his children and his numerous grand children a monument of endearing recollections, on which they may reflect with delight, and whose virtue and example they should imitate. He died as he had lived, rejoicing in the triumphs of Redeeming grace over sin, and the final holiness and happiness of all mankind through the mediation of "the Savior of the world."

His aged wife and children mourn their loss, but not as those without hope.

His funeral was attended at the Baptist church in Stockton, and an address delivered to a large and sympathizing congregation by the Rev.T.C.Eaton.

On Monday afternoon, D.Tenant of this town, who has been confined in the Jail for a few days to prevent him from abusing his family, made an attempt upon his own life by cutting his throat. — Sheriff Rice was absent at the time, and the young man having charge of the jail was in the hall with a couple of persons who wished to see the “cages,” when Mr.T. asked for a knife to cut his nails, which was handed him and he immediately stepped to the glass and made the attempt on his life, cutting a considerable gash on the right side of the neck, and making an opening into the windpipe. Though the wound is a severe one, yet we learn that he is doing well and will in all probability recover. There can be but little doubt that insanity has led to this rash and well nigh fatal deed. (from Mayville *Sentinel*)
