WHEREAS, Chautauqua County has rented office and electronics cage space for a County-operated 911 call center backup center from Windstream since 2018; and

WHEREAS, while the original term of the lease has expired, the space remains available and suitable for the needs of the Sheriff's Office; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the County Executive is authorized and hereby empowered to execute a lease agreement with Windstream New York, Inc. for such office and cage space on substantially the following terms and conditions:

- 1. <u>Premises</u>: Approximately 36 square feet of cage space and approximately 1,620 square feet of office space at 201-209 East Fourth Street, Jamestown, N.Y.
- 2. <u>Term</u>: January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2029.

AT THE REQUEST OF: County Executive Paul M. Wendel, Jr.:

WHEREAS, Chautauqua County, through the Chautauqua County Sheriff's Office, already contracts with Chautauqua Lake Central School District for the provision of enhanced police protection services on an as-needed basis; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office and CLCS administration have discussed a trial program utilizing a full-time uniformed deputy for unscheduled but regular presence at the school district buildings; and

WHEREAS, the trial program would run January 1, 2024, through December 31, 2024, with time of the officer charged at \$48.80 per hour plus a negotiated cost for vehicle and administrative costs; and

WHEREAS, this new contract and the revenue pursuant to this agreement is not included in the 2024 proposed budget; now therefor be it
