

# Chautauqua County Report on Opioid Settlement Funds

Date of Report: 11/1/2025

**Background:** In March 2019, the New York State Attorney General sued several drug manufacturers and distributors for their role in the opioid epidemic. Several of these cases were settled, securing significant funding for the State, cities, and counties. The money received through the Opioid Settlement will support treatment, recovery and abatement efforts.
