Call to Order	The meeting was called to order at 6:01 p.m. by Khan.

Approval of 5/21/26 Minutes	Columbare made a motion to approve the May 2026 minutes. 2 nd by Tarbrake; all in favor; motion carried.
New Business: Agreements to Settle	Agreements to settle were reviewed and discussed. There were several public water supply violations.
Hearing Officer Recommendations	<u>Hearing Summary:</u> In the matter of Smoke Town, LLC Case #26-10, it was determined that the Respondent sold tobacco products to an individual under the age of twenty-one (21).

<i>Hearing Officer Recommendations Cont'd</i>	<u>Discussion Summary:</u> The Board of Health, after review and discussion, unanimously voted in favor of a fine of \$3100, plus two (2) points against the business' NYS tobacco retail license and recommended the case be referred to NYSDOH to move forward with a license suspension. <u>Motion:</u> Dahlgren made a motion for a total fine of \$3,100 and two (2) points on their NYS tobacco retail license. 2nd by Proctor; all in favor; motion carried. <u>Hearing Summary:</u> In the matter of Cassadaga ShurFine, LLC, Case #26-35, it was determined that the Respondent failed to submit multiple required water samples and reports for January 2026, March 2026 and April 2026. <u>Discussion Summary:</u> The Board of Health, after review and discussion, unanimously voted in favor of a fine of \$1200 and an additional \$250 administrative fee. <u>Motion:</u> Proctor made a motion for a total fine of \$1450. 2nd by Krahm; all in favor; motion carried.
Old Business:	Berke recognized recent deaths in the community as they relate to former Environmental Health staff: Don Hustead and his spouse, Mary Hustead, recently passed, as did Michael Vendette.
Director's Report:	Assistant County Attorney, James Williams was introduced to the Board of Health as a legal advisor to the Health Department.
