Pursuant to the New York State Election Law, section 34, we submit the Board of Election's Annual Report for the calendar year of 1974.

Central Voter Registration for the purposes of the 1974 Annual Report began on December 6, 1973. This date is mandated by the New York State Legislature.

June 17th was the first day for circulating Designating Petitions. Dates for filing such petitions was between July 11th and 15th for the September 10th (Tuesday) Primary Election. As a result of such action there were Primary candidates for local and state offices. The County-wide canvass of the voting machines was completed by 5:00 P.M. on September 13th. The results was as follows for Public Offices:

As a result of these Primary contests all 131 Election Districts were open on Tuesday, September 10th from noon to 9:00 P.M. The number of voters participating by party are as follows:

Three Party Primaries occurred in all of the 20 Election Districts of the 149th Assembly District complicating the setting up of the voting machines for 10 custodians. Two Party Primaries occurred in all of the 121 Election Districts in the 150th Assembly District affecting the other 21 Voting Machine Custodians. The 150th Assembly District also had write-in Primary Contests in 30 Election Districts - this necessitated a more complex voting machine setup for the Custodians.

This Primary permitted absentee voting for the first time and mandated the mailing of absentee ballots to Military personnel. This mailing consisted of 130 Democratic Voters County wide, 40 Republicans in the 149th Assembly District, 12 Liberals in the 150th Assembly District and 1 liberal in the 149th Assembly District - a total of 183 ballots were mailed. 57 voted Ballots were returned - - - a 31% response.

Although this office does not in accordance with law, have anything to do with the printing of petitions, we are deluged with questions on proper ways to execute them. This office frequently receives from various individuals seeking public office, or party positions, questions of procedure. It is our advice to these individuals to seek the aid of legal counsel in order to avoid any possible complexities.

Many of these petitions are filed with the Board of Elections. Those persons on whose behalf petitions have been filed are then notified and they can accept or decline the designation. At this point, it has to be established whether or not a Primary Election would occur in any of the offices, and if so, prepare for it.

All Primary Candidates were notified pursuant to E.L. ss 250-A that the voting machines to be used at the Primary were available for inspection by the candidates or their designated representative at 7:00 P.M., Saturday, September 7, 1974 in the polling places so designated.

The dates for holding the 8th Judicial District conventions were on September 13th and 14th, 1974 in Buffalo. No candidate received all four Party endorsements for the three positions of Supreme Court Justice, 8th Judicial District. The last day to fill a vacancy after declination of the Judicial Convention nomination was September 20, 1974, no declinations were received. Six candidates were nominated by the four political parties. All were Erie County residents.

Upon the New York State Legislature's annual passage of the political calendar, the Board of Elections prints the calendar and voter registration information for county-wide distribution. Due to the variations in time of enactment by the New York State Legislature, this office frequently publishes both a tentative and regular political calendar.

Effective this year the State and County Board of Elections are held responsible for candidates filing financial statements. Such report forms were supplied to such candidates and political committees. The 1974 report dates were August 16, September 3, 16, 30 October 11, 28, November 25, 1974 and January 15, 1975. To date all candidates have complied but not without a concerted, time consuming demands by our staff. The 1975 problem will be horrendous with some 500 candidates seeking office compared to 16 local candidates in 1974. The State Board of Elections Fair Campaign Code was distributed to candidates and treasurers of their Finance Committee.

Also, this office printed and distributed to all Candidates, Inspectors of Elections and Party Chairmen, a pamphlet entitled "Certain Sanctioned Procedures and Regulations Relating to Electioneering"; notice of date, time and place to inspect the voting machines being used (E.L. 250-a); a list of polling places and voting machine custodians; recanvass of voting machines, date and places (E.L. ss 274).

In preparation for the Primary and General Election, a School of Instructions for Election Inspectors and Alternates was held in the auditorium of the Hall R. Clothier Memorial Building. A total of 6 afternoon and evening classes were held from September 3rd thru September 5th. A total of 581 attended the six classes (429 Election Inspectors and 52 Alternates). All Election Inspectors are entitled to be paid \$5.00 per day and mileage for attending such school (E.L. 49-a 1).

A centralized school of instructions permits the use of office equipment, supplies and a voting machine. Written examinations were administered to all Election Inspectors and covered many of the recent changes in the Election Law.

A special School of Instructions for the Town of Ellery Election Inspectors was held on Tuesday, October 1, 1974 at 2:00 P.M. at the Ellery Town Highway Building in Ellery Center. The number of voters caused this Township to be increased from 3 to 4 Election Districts for the September 10th Primary and into 5 Election Districts for the October 5th and 10th Voter Registration and the November 5th General Election.

The General Election was held on November 5, 1974. Hours of voting were from 6:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M. The 1974 County total number of Registrations was 75,450 of which 8,904 were removed by legal determinations resulting in 66,546 eligible voters.

One potential major problem occurred with the rupture of a nitric acid tank in Dunkirk about 12:30, ground hugging toxic fumes drifted toward several polling places threatening to close those voting polls. The situation was alleviated by 3:30 P.M.

The day following the General Election, this office received the election supplies which were returned from all of the 132 Election Districts, the bulk of which was received before noon. These districts utilized 163 voting machines. This represented 28 Election

Districts in the County with more than one voting machine.

Bi-partisan teams, consisting of permanent employees began the canvass of the 163 voting machines that very afternoon. This requires personal inspection of the sealed voting machines and verification of the results as recorded by the Election Inspectors. This physical inspection was completed by Friday, at 5:00 P.M. At this time temporary help is needed annually to process the voluminous statistics in order that this office may certify the results within the mandated time.

Due to the time schedules mandated by the New York State Election Law, unusually heavy demands have been made on the County Printing Department by this office. For example Election Law ss 376 mandates the printing of voter Registration lists for each of the new local registered voters of October 5th and October 10th.

In 1972, the U. S. District Court rendered a decision which prohibited, as a voting requirement, durational residence in excess of thirty days before the November General Election. Therefore, this office has to be prepared to register all persons who will have resided at the legal address from which they seek to register for at least 30 days prior to Election Day.

Furthermore, Election Law ss 355, 149a (28), stipulates that a qualified person could move, up to and including Friday, October 25th, thus changing his address and possibly the Election District. Therefore, accurate registration lists must be printed after this date. This office mandated per E.L. 376 (4), for the distribution of lists, not less than six days prior to the day of Election, Wednesday, October 30th. E.L. 376 (5) compels distribution of Registration lists before the 6th day to the Secretary of State and the Attorney General.

The printer will receive in late January, data relative to the registered voters for the completion of printed enrollments (before the first of March, 1975, pursuant to E.L. ss 377). Our efforts to process this data is impeded by E.L. ss 186 which states that we cannot open the enrollment boxes until the Tuesday following the General Election and the process must be completed before the first day of February of the succeeding year.

Increased use of temporary employees for each of the twelve months of the year is due to the continually expanding normal and peak work load. The E.E.A. program provided us with two employees during the summer.

Concomitant with Sec. 377 of the Election Law, Sec. 405 mandates a Purge List begun in the second week in December and be completed not later than the third week in the succeeding January. All permanent records and data related to the more than 66,546 enrolled voters have to be individually examined to verify if the registrant has voted at least

once in a General Election during the past two years. All those that have not must be notified by mail (12,179 individuals - this year compared to 4,471 in 1973) of the impending cancellation of their status as a registered voter unless they fill out, sign and return the re-instatement request form within three weeks of the postmark on the notification. After this three week interval the newly compiled list of registered and enrolled voters is then sent to the printer, pursuant to E.L. ss 377 in conjunction with the need of Section 191 sub. 1-a concerning Spring Primaries.

Registration records under Section 381 and 516 of the Election Law are used for Village and School District Elections. Election Law ss 516 (6a) states, if such village is located in a County wherein Permanent Personal Registration is required, they (Village Inspectors of Elections) shall copy such names from the registration lists certified and supplied by the County Board of Elections.

Since September 1, 1973 all 15 Chautauqua County Village Elections are conducted under Article 17 in the Election Law. Each Village Clerk is the Election Officer for these March Elections. However, the Board of Elections is involved by supplying voter registration lists; publishing Village Election Calendars; and such Election Law and Procedures as are requested. Presently all individuals who are registered with the Board of Elections under P.P.R. are automatically qualified to vote in Village Elections. Conversely, an individual who registers to vote under the Village registration system is not automatically qualified to vote in a November General Election. This person must personally register again under P.P.R. in order to vote in a November General Election, thus many village residents are confused and disenfranchised by this dual system. This office publishes a separate Political Calendar pertaining to the Village Elections and are available for interested individuals.

At least 8 months (March 5th) before the General Election, each County, City, Village and Town Clerk, pursuant to E.L. ss 149-a, sub. 30, shall make and transmit to the Board of Elections, a certificate stating each County, City Village and Town officer respectively to be voted on at the General Election, including any local proposition or question known to such officer at the time of issuance of the certificate. If any officer is to be elected to fill a vacancy, the Certificate shall so state. Within the above time period the Secretary of State shall make and transmit to the Board of Elections, a Certificate stating each office above County level which lawfully may be voted for at the Election. A similar requirement by E.L. ss 67 is required 3 months before the General Election.

The concentration of such information in our office generates many inquiries throughout the year concerning Election Law, Petitions, Party Caucus, Primaries, General Elections, A.B.C. local option, Referendum, Special Elections, School Board Elections, fire Districts, etc.

Further impetus for voter registration was granted by Resolution 228-74 of the County Legislature authorizing and directing the Board of Elections to conduct such a voter registration drive throughout the County. Many of the locations were in Senior High Schools, but open to the public with walk in registrants. Positive response in 18 year old voter registrations in May was 87.5% of preceding two year average. Such registrants are informed of impending School Board Elections, Primaries and the November General Election.

Voter registration in the field is conducted by our permanent staff and temporary help which we use to train many Election Inspectors. The results were as follows:

Section 392 of the New York State Election Law, provides for a special check of all registered voters in any or all of the Election Districts including those previously checked. This personal check of registrants is contingent upon the written, filed request of any one member of the Board of Elections and is conducted by legally constituted bi-partisan teams. This is especially important when one recognizes the fact that one family in five moves annually and the 18-30 age group is highly mobile, 60% of them moving in a three year period from March 1970 to March 1973.

The Central Registration figure of 2,513 plus the two day Local Registration of 3,209 placed a total of 73,426 registrant's names on our rolls. Change of Enrollment Requests were 133.

Section 394 states the Board of Elections, not less than 15 days nor more than 30 days before the first day of Local Registration (October 5th), shall conduct a Mail Check of every registered voter. This entails processing 75,450 letters to the 132 Election Districts and notifying the registrant that such communication is a routine check to ascertain whether such voter still resides at this address. This September mailing resulted in 3,000 letters listed as undeliverable at the indicated address. Within one week after the conclusion of Local Registration the Board of Elections shall send similar communication (3,209) letters (1,962 were transfers) to every voter registered in such Local Registration period.

At this point, pursuant to the Election Law, Sec. 331 sub. 3, this Board calls upon law enforcement agencies to investigate questionable declared and actual voter residency.

Whenever such communication is returned as undeliverable, the Board of Elections forthwith shall proceed in accordance with the powers granted to it by Section 406 to determine whether such registration of the affected person shall be cancelled. This Board received 5,437 letters in 1970; 4,121 letters in 1971; 2,949 in 1972; and 3,000+ as undeliverable in 1973 and 1974. Such legal determinations were made and verified in the 20 days prior to Election Day on November 5th. In addition, this office issued 369 (226 voted) Military and Military dependents ballots compared to 395 and 1,006 from the two previous years.

Absentee ballots issued were 1,053 (914 voted), compared to 1,075 in 1973 and 2,727 in the 1972 Presidential Election and 1,439 in the 1971 Election. Permanent physical disability voters totaled 318 (43 newly added in 1974) with 228 voting, pursuant to E.L. 117-a (3a). The total requests of military, absentee and physical disability voters was 2,058 compared to 1,745 in 1974.

Pursuant to the order of Federal District Judge Edward Weinfeld, all Boards of Elections in New York State were instructed to canvass all absentee ballots received or returned by 9:00 P.M. Election night on November 5, 1974. In order to comply, our office made arrangements to pick up the mail in the Mayville Post Office and the Jamestown Sectional Center and counted those ballots centrally.

This office is in reality, an office of vital statistics of the most current information available on a County wide basis. Each and every month pursuant to Section 397

sub. 1, this office receives from the public recording officers of the 15 villages, 27 towns, and 2 cities, the deaths in their respective areas in order that we may remove the deceased person from the current registration list. The number of cancelled forms due to deaths was 600 (compared to 643 in 1973); moving, etc. came to 4,846 for the year 1974 (4,196 in 1973). The continual updating of names and addresses as mandated by the Election Law, of Chautauqua County residents in our office results in many requests for information from the Courts, FBI, Social Security Administration, attorneys, private agencies, and individuals. This office is one source of names and addresses to the Federal and County Courts for use as potential jurors. In fact, this office provides many such services for several County Departments.

Beginning the first day of Central Registration on December 5, 1974 and thereafter, all persons 18 years of age or older who are otherwise qualified to vote, would be eligible to register and vote at all Primary, Special and General Elections held on or after December 5, 1974. This includes the right of Special Enrollment for the 1975 Primary Election for such new voters, pursuant to Section 187 and 388 of the Election Law.

There is a tendency to decentralize government in Chautauqua County by establishing branch offices in the Dunkirk and Jamestown areas. Census figures reveal that the Dunkirk and Jamestown quadrants contain 30% and 50% respectively of the County population.

Government exists to serve its constituents. The establishing of branch automobile license offices is such an example. This office believes in the establishing of Board of Elections branch offices in the Dunkirk and Jamestown areas.

Chautauqua County joins Albany and Chemung in adopting charters that provide for elected County Executives with wide powers to supervise the administration of their Governments. On January 1st, 1975, 17 of the 57 Counties outside New York City will have a charter form of Government with a strong Executive.
