Pursuant to the New York State EL. ss 34, and ss 15.09 of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code, we submit the Board of Election's annual report for the calendar year of 1976.

The political year began with Central voter registration, (EL. ss 355), for the purposes of the 1976 annual report on Thursday, December 4, 1975. Mail registration began on Monday, December 1st, 1975. This created a ludicrous 3 day technicality where mail registration forms should be used for registration when registrants appeared at the Board of Elections office. Both dates were mandated by the New York State Legislature.

The printer will receive in late January, data relative to the registered voters for the completion of printed enrollments (before the first of March, 1976, pursuant to EL. ss 377). Our efforts to process this data is impeded by EL. ss 186 which states that we cannot open the entire years' enrollment until the Tuesday following the General Election, and the process must be completed before the first day of February of the succeeding year.

In addition to this being a Presidential Election year, the office participated in a special 39th Congressional District election on March 2nd; Party primaries for Presidential delegate slates (4), and state and county committee positions on April 6th; two party public office primaries for U.S. Senator involving 7 candidates, plus 1 party primary 57th State Senate, and Town of Ellicott Councilman on September 14th. The March 2nd Special Election saw 32,001 people (46.6%) of the 68,616 eligible voters go to the polls which were open from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Of these, 19,231 came from the 27 towns and 12,770 from the two cities. The county-wide canvass was completed by Friday, March 5th and certified the following week. Absentee ballots were accepted from February 2nd through February 24th (EL. 117(6)). This election caused Central Registration to close on February 23rd and re-open again on March 8th

pursuant to (EL ss 355).

Concomitant with Sec.377 of the Election Law, ss 405 which mandates a Purge List begun in the second week in December and be completed not later than the third week in the succeeding January. All permanent records and data related to the more than 65,366 enrolled voters have to be individually examined to verify if the registrant has voted at least once in a General Election during the past two years. All those that have not must be notified by mail..... 4,363 individuals this year compared to 4,775 in 1975; 12,179 in 1974; 4,471 in 1973 of the impending cancellation of their status as a registered voter unless they fill out, sign and return the re-instatement request form within three weeks of the post mark on the notification. After this three week interval the newly compiled list of registered and enrolled voters is then sent to the printer, pursuant to EL,ss 377 in conjunction with the need of EL ss 191 (1a) concerning Primary elections.

Registration records under EL ss 381 and 516 are used for Village and School District elections. EL,ss 516 (6a) states, if such village does not require Permanent Personal Registration, they (Village Inspectors of Elections) shall adopt or copy such names from the registration lists certified and supplied by the County Board of Elections to the extent applicable.

Since September 1, 1973 all 15 county Village Elections are conducted under Article 17 of the Election Law. Each Village Clerk is the Election Officer (EL, ss 522) for these March elections. However, the Board of Elections is involved by supplying voter registration lists; publishing Village Election calendars; canvassing voting machines upon request; and such Election Law and procedures as are requested. Persons who are registered with the Board of Elections under P.P.R. are automatically qualified to vote in village elections. Conversely, an individual who registers to vote under the village registration system is NOT automatically qualified to vote in a November General Election. This person must personally register again under P.P.R. or use the recently enacted mail registration form in order to vote in a November General Election. Thus many village residents are confused and disenfranchised by this dual system.

At least 6 months before the General Election, each County, City, Village, and Town Clerk, pursuant to EL, ss 149-a, Sub.36 shall make and transmit to the Board of Elections, a certificate stating each County, City,Village, and Town officer respectively, to be voted on at the General Election, including any local proposition or question

known to such officer at the time of issuance of the certificate. If any officer is to be elected to fill a vacancy the Certificate shall so state. Within the above time period the Secretary of State shall make and transmit to the Board of Elections, a certificate stating each office above County level which lawfully may be voted for at the election. A similar requirement by EL, ss 67 is required 3 months before the General Election.

The concentration of such information in our office generates many inquiries throughout the year concerning Election Law, Petitions, Party Caucus, Primaries, General Elections, A.B.C. local option, Referendum, Special Elections, School Board Elections, Fire Districts, etc.

This year was characterized by two Primaries. The first on April 6th for National Convention Delegates, State and County Committee members. All of the 132 polling places were open due to 39th Congressional District Democratic Primary contest between 4 competing slates. Of the 27,098 enrolled Democrats 7,422 voted (27.39%). In addition, there were 9 aspirants to 6 county committee positions in three Jamestown election districts. This April 6th Primary was the third one permitted since enactment 3 years ago.

The petition filing date for this Party Primary was February 19, 1976.

Although this office does not in accordance with law, have anything to do with the printing of petitions, we are deluged with questions on proper ways to execute them. This office frequently receives from various individuals seeking public office questions of procedure. It is our advice to these individuals to seek the aid of legal counsel in order to avoid any possible complexities; despite this advice office seekers are disqualified and/or resort to Court action.

These petitions are filed with the Board of Elections. Those persons on whose behalf petitions have been filed are then notified and they can accept or decline the designation. At this point it has to be established whether or not a Primary election would occur in any of the offices, and if so, prepare for it.

All Primary candidates were notified pursuant to EL,ss 250a that the voting machines to be used at the Primary Election were available for inspection by the candidates or their designated representative at 7:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 11, 1976 in the polling places so designated.

This office has now completed our fifth annual voter registration drive within the High Schools of Chautauqua County and other areas. Positive response to this effort is shown in the figures shown below which gives a five year total for comparison. Such registrants are informed of absentee voting, impending school board elections, primaries, special elections, and the November General Election.

High School voter registration and field registration is conducted by our permanent staff and temporary help which we use to train many Election Inspectors. The results were as follows:

The town of Chautauqua Special Election was held on May 25th. The proposition asked if the Chautauqua Utility District should contract indebtedness in an amount not exceeding \$2,400,000 for the purpose of financing the construction of a secondary sewage treatment plant. All 4 polling places were open for this Special Election. This office provided the expertise needed.

Candidates for public offices began circulation of petitions on June 15, 1976. Dates for filing were between July 12th-15th. The last day to authorize designation or to accept or decline was July 19th and the last day to fill any vacancies was on July 22nd. Certification by the State Board of Elections for August 17th was detained by several court actions for the September 14th Primary.

National Convention dates were: July 12-15 for the Democratic Party in New York City, and for the Republican Party in Kansas City on August 16-19th. During

the week of July 26-30 the Board of Elections conducted voter registration at the Chautauqua County Fair in Dunkirk, New York.

Dates for filing Financial Statement reports for the September 14th Primary were August 20, September 7, and October 4th.

In preparation for the Primary and General Elections a School of Instructions for Election Inspectors and Alternates was held in the Hall R. Clothier Building auditorium. A total of 6 afternoon and evening classes were held from August 30th through September 1st. A total of 497 persons attended the six classes. All Election Inspectors are entitled to be paid \$5.00 per day and mileage at the rate of 15¢ per mile for attending such school (EL.ss 49a-1).

A centralized school of instructions permits the use of office equipment, supplies, and a voting machine. Written examinations were administered to all of these inspectors and covered many of the recent changes in the Election Law.

This is the fourth Primary Election that permitted absentee voting since enactment in 1974 yielded these results.

This is the second year all county Boards of Election were mandated by law to obtain "unofficial" results the night of Primary and General elections (EL ss 214-b). Completed report time is as follows for the September Primary:

This typifies the new work-loads that are placed on Boards of Elections by Federal, State, and/or Court decisions. The major problem is that this office is one of the largest offices in County government with absolutely ZERO DOLLARS received from these august bodies to carry out their mandates!

The canvas of these machines were made by Friday, Sept. 17th in all 132 Election Districts. The voter participation by Political party was:

Due to the time schedules mandated by the New York State Election Law, unusually heavy demands have been made on the County Printing Department by this office. For example, E.L. ss 376 mandates the printing of voter registration lists for each of the new local registered voters of October 2nd and 5th.

In 1972 the U.S. District Court rendered a decision which prohibited as a voting requirement, durational residence in excess of thirty days before the November General Election. Therefore, this office has to be prepared to register all persons who will have resided at the legal address from which they seek to register for at least 30 days prior to Election Day.

Furthermore, E.L. ss 355, 149a (34), stipulates that a qualified person could move up to and including Friday, October 22nd, thus changing his address and possibly the election district. Therefore, accurate registration lists must be printed after this date. This office mandated per E.L. ss 376 (4), for the distribution of lists not less than six days prior to the day of election, Wednesday, October 27th. E.L. ss 376 (5) compels distribution of Registration Lists before the 6th day to the Secretary of State and the Attorney General.

The Central Registration figure of 6419 plus the two day Local Registration of 4824 placed a total of 76,609 registrant's names on our rolls. Change of Enrollment requests were 245 compared to 211 in 1975 and 133 in 1974.

E.L. ss 394 states the Board of Elections, not less than 15 days nor more than 30 days before the first day of Local Registration (October 2nd) shall conduct a Mail Check of every registered voter. This entails processing 74,045 letters to the 132 Election Districts and notifying the registrant that such communication is a routine check to ascertain whether such voter still resides at this address. Within one week after the conclusion of Local Registration the Board of Elections shall send similar communication 4824 letters to every voter registered in such Local Registration period.

At this point, pursuant to the E.L. ss 331 (3), this Board calls upon law enforcement agencies to investigate questionable declared and actual voter residency.

Whenever such communication is returned as undeliverable, the Board of Election forthwith shall proceed in accordance with the powers granted to it by E.L. ss 406, to determine whether such registration of the affected person shall be cancelled. Such legal determinations were made and verified in the 20 days prior to Election Day on November 2nd. In 1976 this Board cancelled 7047 registrants, 617 were deceased (8.76%).

Presidential Election years generate substantially higher voter participation in both number and percent.

This was the first year for Special Presidential Voters. Registered Voters who moved out of State to the Jurisdiction of another Board of Elections within 30 days of the General Election (after Oct.3) may vote for electors for President and Vice President only by applying to their previous Board not later than the seventh day before the Election (Oct. 26) for a special presidential ballot (E.L. ss 341; ss 342 (1a)). This office had twelve such applicants, none from either city.

Special Federal Voter applicants numbered nine and apply to all U.S. citizens residing outside the United States. These individuals may vote for: Electors for President and Vice President, U.S. Senator, and Representative in Congress.

This office is in reality, an office of vital statistics of the most current information available on a county-wide basis. Each and every month pursuant to E.L. ss 397 (1), this office receives from the public recording officers of the 15 villages, 27 towns, and 2 cities, the deaths in their respective areas in order that we may remove the deceased person from the current registration list. The number of cancelled voters due to deaths was 617 compared to 656 in 1975, 600 in 1974 and 643 in 1973; moving etc., came to 4,365; 12,822 in 1975, 4846 for the year 1974 (4,196 in 1973). The continual updating of names and addresses as mandated by the Election Law, of Chautauqua County residents in our office results

in many requests for information from the Courts, FBI, Social Security Administration, attorneys, private agencies, and individuals.

This office is one source of names and addresses to the Federal and County Courts for use as potential jurors. In fact, this office provides many such services for several County Departments.

On December 1, 1975 Registration and Enrollment by mail first went into effect. This portion of E.L. ss 153 was enacted by Chapter 166, Laws of 1975. A total of 2,260 mail registration forms were recieved and processed. Some 15,000 forms were given out. Many "citizen" groups promised faithfully to conduct effective voter registration drives.

In order to facilitate voter registration these forms are now available at the Clerk's office of the two cities, 15 villages, and 27 towns. Voter registration by mail is now legal in 15 states containing 41 per cent of the nation's potential voters.

There is a tendency to decentralize government in Chautauqua County by establishing branch offices in the Dunkirk and Jamestown areas. Census figures reveal that within a ten mile radius of Dunkirk and Jamestown 80 percent of the population reside.

Government exists to serve its constituents. The establishing of branch automobile license offices is such an example. This office believes in the establishing of Board of Elections branch offices in the Dunkirk and Jamestown areas.
